Aquarium Maintenance Simplified

Thank you for purchasing Algone. Regular use of Algone will greatly improve the water quality in your aquarium. As with all other aquarium maintenance products it is essential to continue with good maintenance practices such as regular water changes, periodic cleaning of the filters, etc.

Algone is safe for use in all aquaria including freshwater, saltwater, fish only tanks, planted aquariums, reef tanks, etc. Note for planted aquariums: Nitrate levels should be regularly checked and kept at approx. 5 ppm.

Directions for Use

How do I treat for an existing problem? Use the recommended dosage as outlined below. Place Algone pouch(es) into the filter or directly into the tank. Replace every 5 days until nitrate, nitrite, and/or ammonia have dropped to desired levels or the water has cleared up.

How do I use Algone for preventive maintenance? Use recommended treatment dosage as outlined below twice a month.

How much Algone should I use?

Algone for 'Small to Medium Aquariums' (for aquariums up to 125 gallons):

Use 1 pouch in tanks up to 55 gallons (210 l). For larger tanks simply use 1 pouch for each 55 gallons (210 l) of water. Example: For a 75 or 90 gallon (280 or 340 l) tank use 2 pouches. For tanks 125 gallons (475 l) and up use 'Algone for Large Tanks & Small Ponds'.

Algone for "Large Aquariums & Small Ponds" (for aquariums 125 gallons & up):

Use 1 pouch in tanks 125 - 200 gallons (475 - 750 l). For larger tanks simply use 1 pouch for each 200 gallons (750 l) of water. Example: For a 375 gallon (1420 l) tank use 2 pouches. For tanks smaller than 125 gallons (475l) use 'Algone for Small to Medium Tanks'.

What should I do before starting with Algone? When treating for nitrate, nitrite, or ammonia, as well as cloudy water we recommend you do your usual water change and routine cleaning before adding Algone to the filter. If you are treating for cloudy water DO NOT change more than 10 -15% of the water prior to and during treatment as this will result in a further imbalance in the water column.

Where do I place the Algone Pouch? (Insert entire pouch. Do not open pouch!)

Power Filter	Simply drop the Algone pouch(es) into the filter box
Canister Filter	Place the Algone pouch(es) into a media container within the filter
Undergravel Filter	Secure the Algone pouch(es) directly inside the tank (use a veggie clip). preferably near water flow from the air pump or power head used
Wet-Dry/Sump	Place Algone pouch(es) directly into the wet-dry/sump
Other Filters	Algone can be placed anywhere in the aquarium provided it is fully submerged in the water. For optimal results place pouch in water flow if possible

How fast can I expect results? Treatment times vary greatly depending on individual tank conditions. A well maintained tank that is not over populated or overfed will show faster results than a poorly maintained tank. Results usually vary from as little as 5 days up to 6 weeks. It is important to continue to use Algone as recommended above even if no initial results can be seen. If you are new to the hobby of fishkeeping we strongly recommend that you also follow good maintenance and feeding practices. Please visit us at algone.com for extensive fishkeeping resources.
